Nano Blue Butterfly Bush 4-6 x 4-6

Blue Mist Spirea Caryopteris Incana 3-4 x 3-4

Mock Bearberry evergreen flowers & berries 1-2 x 3-4

Pawnee Sandcherry low growing 12-18"x 6-8'

Potentillas yellow,white,pink flowers 3-4 x 3-5

Littleleaf Mountain Mahogany Small leaf evergreen 5-7 x 4-6

Fernbush Chamaebatiaria Millefolium semi evergreen white flowers 6-8 x 4-6

Apache Plume Fallugia paradoxa showy/white flowers 6-8 x 6-8

Royal Smoke Bush Cotinus Coggygria 10-15 x 10-15

Cheyenne Mock Orange Philadelphus Lewisii "Cheyenne" white fragrant flowers 6-9 x 5-8

Littleleaf Mock Orange Philadelphus Microphyllus white fragrant flowers 5-6 x 4-5

Golden Current Ribes Aureum Yellow Flowers 5-6 x 5-6
