3-4 x 3-5 yellow, white, pink flowers

Littleleaf Mountain Mahogany.

Small leafed evergreen.

5-7 x 4-6

Fernbush

Chamaebatiaria millefolium

Semi evergreen white flowers

6-8 x 4-6

Apache Plume

Fallugia paradoxa. Snowy/white flowers

6-8 x 6-8

Royal Smoke Bush

Cotinus coggygia

10-15 x 10-15

Cheyenne Mock Orange

Philadelphus lewosoo "Cheyenne"

6-9 x 5-8 White fragrant flowers

Littleleaf Mock Orange

Philadelphus microphyllus

5-6 x 4-5 white fragrant flowers

Golden Current

Ribes aureum

5-6 x 5-6 yellow flowers
